The 9th Annual Dungeness Crab & Seafood Festival (DCSF) will take place Saturday-Sunday, October 9-10, 2010 in Port Angeles. “Crabfest” has become one of the major seafood events in the country, one of Coastal Living Magazine’s “Top 10 Events.” Nearly 20,000 people from all over the country attended the Festival.

The festival is held in a new larger site including the Port Angeles City Pier, Port Angeles Red Lion Hotel, the Gateway Center, and Lincoln Street. There is plenty of free parking within a few blocks and there is no admission charge to the festival. The Festival is supported by the City of Port Angeles, many great sponsors, vendors, volunteers, and the public because this is the “Home of the Dungeness Crab.”

The festival’s featured crustacean was named after the village of Dungeness (near Port Angeles), where the oldest known commercial shellfish fishery of the North American Pacific coast began in 1848. People all over the world love Dungeness Crab, and we are working to bring them to Port Angeles at the beginning of the local crab season to eat crab, and sample all of the other great foods and products of the Olympic Peninsula.

We are seeking applications from craftspeople and merchants, especially with products relating to the theme of the Festival.
